Representative Pelanda was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 248-Representatives Hagan, C., Wachtmann.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, J., Adams, R., Beck, Becker, Blair, Blessing, Boose, Brenner, Buchy, Burkley, Butler, Conditt, Derickson, Hackett, Hall, Hayes, Henne, Hill, Hood, Hottinger, Huffman, Johnson, Lynch, Maag, McClain, Retherford, Roegner, Romanchuk, Rosenberger, Ruhl, Schuring, Slaby, Smith, Sprague, Stautberg, Terhar, Thompson, Young.

To amend sections 2919.171, 2919.19, 2919.191, 2919.192, 2919.193, and 4731.22; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicted in parentheses, sections 2919.191 (2919.192), 2919.192 (2919.194), and 2919.193 (2919.198); and to enact new sections 2919.191 and 2919.193 and sections 2919.195, 2919.196, 2919.197, 2919.199, 2919.1910, and 2919.1911 of the Revised Code to generally prohibit an abortion of an unborn human individual with a detectable heartbeat and to create the Joint Legislative Committee on Adoption Promotion and Support.

H. B. No. 249-Representative Boose.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brenner, Grossman, Hood, Rosenberger, Ruhl, Stebelton, Wachtmann.

To enact section 4511.052 of the Revised Code to permit farm machinery to be operated on a portion of United States Route 20 within Huron County only.

H. B. No. 250-Representative Becker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lynch, Brenner, Adams, J.

To amend sections 3509.01 and 3511.10 of the Revised Code to reduce the days for absent voting.

H. B. No. 251-Representative Barborak.

Cosponsors: Representatives Conditt, O'Brien, Pillich, Rogers.

To amend sections 2925.02, 2925.03, 2925.06, 2925.11, 2925.13, 2925.22, 2925.23, 2925.36, 2925.37, 2929.13, 2951.041, and 2953.08 of the Revised Code to eliminate the special sentencing mechanism that applies for most felonies of the fourth and fifth degree and that generally provides for a community control sanction for such offenses.

H. B. No. 252-Representatives Gerberry, Celebrezze.

To amend section 102.99 and to enact section 102.10 of the Revised Code to prohibit Ohio statewide elective officers from receiving compensation while in office from any entity.

Said bills were considered the first time.
