INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 614-Representative Huffman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pelanda, Stebelton.

To amend sections 2901.21 and 2901.22 and to enact section 2901.20 of the Revised Code to clarify when strict criminal liability is imposed or a degree of culpability is required for the commission of an offense, to modify the concept of acting recklessly, and to require that future acts creating criminal offenses specify the requisite degree of culpability.

H. B. No. 615-Representative Perales.

Cosponsors: Representatives Terhar, Foley.

To amend sections 3737.82, 3781.10, 3781.104, and 4740.14 of the Revised Code to require a separate, exterior means of egress for dwelling areas above the second story of certain residential rental properties.

Said bills were considered the first time.
