INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 616-Representative DeVitis.
Cosponsors: Representatives Terhar, Butler, Thompson, Milkovich, Hagan, C.

To enact section 3345.47 of the Revised Code with regard to the selection, availability, and purchase of textbooks that are required for a course offered by any state institution of higher education.

H. B. No. 617-Representative DeVitis.
Cosponsors: Representatives Butler, Becker, Duffey, Bishoff, Retherford, Grossman, Perales, Reece.

To amend section 4503.102 of the Revised Code to require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and all deputy registrars to accept credit and debit cards for all transactions.

Said bills were considered the first time.
