The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 271-Representative Becker.

To amend sections 2305.234 and 2305.2341 of the Revised Code to expand the immunity from liability for health care professionals, health care workers, and nonprofit health care referral organizations when providing specific care to an indigent and uninsured person.

H. B. No. 272-Representative Hagan, R.

Cosponsors: Representatives Foley, Sheehy, Antonio, Letson, Reece, Lundy, Ramos.

To enact sections 1319.30, 1319.31, 1319.32, 1319.33, and 1319.34 of the Revised Code to prohibit debt collectors and creditors from failing to provide consumers with certain information regarding the consumer's debt.

Said bills were considered the first time.

BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

Am. Sub. S. B. No. 5-Senators Brown, Manning.

Cosponsors: Senators Schiavoni, Seitz, Kearney, Sawyer, LaRose, Hite, Bacon, Jones, Tavares, Turner, Smith, Uecker, Lehner, Coley, Beagle, Eklund, Patton, Balderson, Widener, Faber, Obhof, Schaffer, Gardner, Hughes, Oelslager, Peterson.

To enact section 2921.231 of the Revised Code to require wireless service providers to provide device location information to law enforcement officers or agencies in certain emergency situations, was taken up for consideration the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill pass?"

Representative Hackett moved that **Am. Sub. S. B. No. 5**-Senators Brown, Manning, et al., be informally passed and that it be taken up for consideration on: Wednesday, October 2, 2013.

The motion was agreed to.
