**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 644**-Representative McClain.

To enact section 5534.42 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of United States Route 23 within Wyandot County as the "OSHP Sgt. John F. Best Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 645**-Representative Kunze.

To amend Sections 263.10 and 263.230 of Am. Sub. H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly, as subsequently amended, to earmark funds for a pre-K through 5 Language and Literacy Program and to establish the program guidelines.

**H. B. No. 646**-Representative Maag.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, R., Becker, Henne.

To amend sections 2929.03, 2929.04, 2929.06, 2929.14, 2941.148, 2971.03, 2971.07, and 5120.61 of the Revised Code to change the sentence for aggravated murder that is committed purposely and with prior calculation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
