## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 318**-Representatives Roegner, O'Brien.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lynch, Becker, Thompson, Wachtmann, Hood, Ruhl.

To amend sections 4503.312 and 4517.22 of the Revised Code to permit a new motor vehicle dealer to display new motor vehicles at a location other than the dealer's licensed location if such display is for an educational institution, to alter the statutory procedures governing motor vehicle shows, and to clarify the law governing the retail sale of utility and certain other trailers.

**H. B. No. 319**-Representative Grossman.

To amend section 4909.05 and to enact sections 4929.16, 4929.161, 4929.162, 4929.163, 4929.164, 4929.165, 4929.166, 4929.167, and 4929.168 of the Revised Code to permit natural gas companies to apply for an infrastructure development rider to cover costs of certain economic development projects.

**H. B. No. 320**-Representative Young.

To amend sections 2305.234, 2305.2341, 4715.42, 4723.271, 4731.295, and 5747.01 and to enact sections 5.2290, 4723.26, and 5747.78 of the Revised Code to create a state income tax deduction regarding certain health care services provided at a free clinic; to extend qualified immunity from civil liability for certain volunteer health care services provided to individuals eligible for or receiving Medicaid; to authorize a person practicing under a volunteer's certificate to provide health care services to any person; to create a volunteer's certificate for retired nurses; and to designate December as "Free Clinic Appreciation Month."
