H. B. No. 674-Representatives Budish, Celebrezze.
Cosponsor: Representative Antonio.

To amend sections 2743.56, 2743.68, 2743.70, and 2743.71 of the Revised Code to eliminate the period of limitations for a minor to file a victim's reparations application and for the filing of supplemental reparations applications and to increase the court costs for certain misdemeanors that fund the Reparations Fund.
