The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Derickson was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 360-Representatives Foley, Hagan, R.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ashford, Patterson, Antonio.

To amend sections 4111.03 and 4111.10 and to enact section 4113.75 of the Revised Code to require treble wages for retail employees who work during the Thanksgiving holiday and to prohibit a retail employer from adversely affecting the employment status, wages, hours, or employment conditions of a retail employee because the retail employee refuses to work on Thanksgiving day.

H. B. No. 361-Representatives Gonzales, Smith.

Cosponsor: Representative Landis.

To amend section 1739.05 and to enact sections 1751.68, 3901.046, and 3923.591 of the Revised Code to prohibit health insurers from excluding coverage related to acquired brain injuries.

H. B. No. 362-Representatives Scherer, Derickson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Anielski, Blessing, Butler, Roegner, Young.

To amend sections 3301.162, 3314.03, 3326.02, 3326.03, 3326.04, and 3326.09 and to enact section 3326.032 of the Revised Code to authorize the STEM Committee to grant a designation of STEM school equivalent to a community school or chartered nonpublic school and to make other revisions to the law regarding STEM schools.

H. B. No. 363-Representatives Sprague, Driehaus.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, J., Antonio, Buchy, Grossman, Hackett, Patterson, Phillips, Scherer, Sears, Sheehy, Smith, Wachtmann.

To amend section 2925.11 of the Revised Code to provide an immunity from arrest, prosecution, conviction, or supervised release sanctioning for a

minor drug possession offense for a person who seeks or obtains medical assistance for self or another person who is experiencing a medical emergency as a result of ingesting drugs or alcohol or for a person who is experiencing such a medical emergency and for whom medical assistance is sought.

H. B. No. 364-Representative DeVitis.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Adams, J., Hood, Maag, Mallory, Terhar, Young.

To enact sections 4561.51 to 4561.60 of the Revised Code to regulate the use of unmanned aerial vehicles in this state.

Said bills were considered the first time.
