INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 365-Representatives Stinziano, Duffey.

Cosponsors: Representatives Barborak, Becker, Blessing, Buchy, Budish, Cera, Curtin, Henne, Hood, O'Brien, Slesnick, Terhar, Thompson.

To enact section 5703.71 of the Revised Code to require the Tax Commissioner to notify a taxpayer that the taxpayer has overpaid certain business taxes.

H. B. No. 366-Representative Sprague.

Cosponsors: Representatives Buchy, Hood, Phillips, Ruhl, Smith.

To amend section 3712.06 of the Revised Code to require hospice care programs to establish procedures to prevent diversion of controlled substances that contain opioids.

H. B. No. 367-Representatives Driehaus, Sprague.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Butler, Fedor, Hackett, Perales, Smith.

To amend section 3313.60 of the Revised Code to require the health curriculum of each school district to include instruction in prescription opioid abuse prevention.

H. B. No. 368-Representative Lynch.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Brenner, Cera, Thompson.

To enact sections 4933.26 and 4933.27 of the Revised Code to establish rights for public utility customers regarding smart meters installed on their premises.

Said bills were considered the first time.
