**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 44**-Senator Bacon.

To authorize the civil commitment of certain sexually violent predators and to provide for the GPS monitoring of sexually violent predators who are released from prison.

**S. B. No. 45**-Senator Tavares.

To amend sections 4112.02, 4112.05, 4112.08, 4112.14, 4112.15, and 4112.99 of the Revised Code to prohibit employers, employment agencies, personnel placement services, and labor organizations from requiring an applicant or employee to provide access to private electronic accounts of the applicant or employee.

**S. B. No. 46**-Senator Schiavoni.

Cosponsor: Senator LaRose.

To amend sections 1509.99 and 3734.99 and to enact section 1509.16 of the Revised Code to increase criminal penalties for violations of the Oil and Gas Law relating to improper disposal, transport, and management of brine, to establish a criminal penalty for a negligent violation of certain provisions of the Solid, Hazardous, and Infectious Wastes Law, and to require the revocation of a violator's permits and registration certificate and denial of future permit and registration certificate applications under the Oil and Gas Law.

**S. B. No. 47**-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsor: Senator Eklund.

To amend sections 3.02, 302.09, 305.02, 503.24, 733.31, 1901.10, 2301.02, 3501.301, 3501.38, 3503.06, 3503.14, 3503.16, 3503.19, 3503.28, 3505.13, 3505.18, 3505.181, 3505.182, 3505.183, 3509.03, 3509.04, 3509.05, 3511.02,

3511.05, 3511.09, 3513.04, 3513.262, 3513.263, 3513.30, 3513.31, and 3519.16 and to enact section 3501.302 of the Revised Code to revise the Election Law.
