The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 3, the Clerk called the Senate to order.

Senator LaRose was selected to preside according to the rule.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 49**-Senator Patton.

Cosponsors: Senators Seitz, Gardner.

To enact sections 3959.18, 3964.01 to 3964.09, and 5111.0216 of the Revised Code to establish standards for physician designations by health care insurers.

**S. B. No. 50**-Senator Manning.

Cosponsor: Senator Lehner.

To amend section 955.08 of the Revised Code to authorize county auditors to issue dog registration tags that are valid for more than one year and include a QR code on dog registration tags.

**S. B. No. 51**-Senator Coley.

Cosponsors: Senators Hite, Beagle, Jones, Schaffer.

To amend sections 4781.40, 5301.072, and 5311.191 and to enact section 5321.131 of the Revised Code to prohibit manufactured homes park operators, condominium associations, neighborhood associations, and landlords from restricting the display of blue star banners, gold star banners, and other service flags, and to prohibit manufactured homes park operators and landlords from restricting the display of the United States flag.

**S. B. No. 52**-Senator Coley.

To amend sections 307.699, 3735.67, 5715.19, 5715.27, and 5717.01 of the Revised Code to permit property tax complaints to be initiated only by the property owner.

**S. B. No. 53**-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Smith, Tavares, Schiavoni, Turner, Seitz.

To amend section 4503.102 of the Revised Code to require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and all deputy registrars to accept credit and debit cards for transactions of more than ten dollars.

**S. B. No. 54**-Senators Kearney, Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Gentile, Smith, Sawyer, Tavares, Schiavoni, Turner, Lehner, Jones.

To enact section 4731.45 of the Revised Code to require a physician interpreting a mammogram who determines that the patient has dense breast tissue to specify this in the mammography report sent to the patient.

**S. B. No. 55**-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Smith, Tavares, Schiavoni, Brown, Turner, Jones.

To enact section 9.54 of the Revised Code to establish language standards for signs containing the international symbol of access.

**S. B. No. 56**-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Sawyer, Turner.

To amend sections 126.35 and 5747.11 and to enact section 5747.114 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Taxation to provide taxpayers the option of receiving their income tax refund in the form of a prepaid debit card.
