Senator Jordan reports for the Standing Committee on Reference, recommending that the following bills, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

Am. H. B. No. 416-Representatives Burkley, Hill, et al.

To amend Section 733.10 of Am. Sub. H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly to permit up to two additional school "calamity" days in the 2013-2014 school year; to authorize, for the 2013-2014 school year, schools to make up in half-hour increments "calamity" days missed in excess of the number of days permitted by law; to permit the Superintendent of Public Instruction to delay the return of the student scores for the elementary state achievement assessments for the 2013-2014 school year; to permit school districts to hold up to two additional in-service days for the 2013-2014 school year; and to declare an emergency.

To the Committee on Education.

S. B. No. 284-Senator Coley.

To amend Section 733.10 of Am. Sub. H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly to provide additional calamity day relief for schools and to declare an emergency.

To the Committee on Education.

S. B. No. 285-Senator Gentile.

To enact section 5533.609 of the Revised Code to designate State Route 147 within Noble County as the "Navy Diver 1st Class James E. Reyher Memorial Highway."

To the Committee on Transportation.

S. B. No. 286-Senator Gentile.

To enact section 5533.841 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 43 within Carroll County as the "McKayla Jade Hoopes Memorial Highway."

To amend sections 135.14, 135.142, 135.143, 135.35, and 3770.06 and to enact section 135.48 of the Revised Code to modify authorized investments of interim moneys and inactive moneys under the Uniform Depository Act.

S. B. No. 288-Senator Eklund.

To amend section 2329.66 and to enact sections 143.01 to 143.11 of the Revised Code to create the Volunteer Police Officers' Dependents Fund to provide death benefits to survivors of volunteer police officers killed in the line of duty and disability benefits to disabled volunteer police officers.
