INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 309-Senators Beagle, Tavares.

Cosponsor: Senator Seitz.

To amend section 5725.33 of the Revised Code to modify the qualifications for the New Markets Tax Credit and the schedule for receiving the credit.

S. B. No. 310-Senator Balderson.

To amend sections 4928.20, 4928.64, 4928.65, and 4928.66 and to enact sections 4928.641 and 4928.661 of the Revised Code to make changes to the renewable energy, energy efficiency, and peak demand reduction requirements and to create a study committee.

S. B. No. 311-Senators Tavares, Lehner.

Cosponsor: Senator Skindell.

To amend sections 3109.51, 3109.78, 3109.79, 3109.80, 3313.649, and 5103.99, to amend section 5103.17 and to recodify and subdivide it into sections 5103.17 and 5103.172, and to enact sections 3109.81, 3109.82, 3109.83, 3109.831, 3109.832, 3109.833, 3109.834, 3109.835, 3109.836, 3109.837, 3109.84, 3109.85, 3109.86, 3109.87, 3109.88, 3109.89, 3109.90, 3109.901, 3109.91, 3109.92, 3109.93, 3109.94, 3109.941, 3109.95, 3109.96, 3109.97, 3109.971, 3109.99, 5103.171, and 5103.173 of the Revised Code to revise the child custody law to include temporary physical care powers of attorney for children and to permit certain entities to advertise the adoption of children.
