**REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND  
CONSIDERATION**

Senator Jordan reports for the Standing Committee on Reference, recommending that the following bills and resolutions, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

**H. C. R. No. 9**-Representative Adams, J., et al.

To urge the United States Department of State to approve the presidential permit application allowing the construction and operation of the TransCanada Keystone XL Pipeline between the United States and Canada.

To the Committee on Public Utilities.

**Sub. H. B. No. 1**-Representatives Derickson, Romanchuk, et al.

To amend sections 6301.01, 6301.02, 6301.03, 6301.04, 6301.06, 6301.07, 6301.08, 6301.09, 6301.10, and 6301.12 of the Revised Code to require a local workforce investment area to use OhioMeansJobs as the local workforce investment area's job placement system, to rename county one-stop systems, and to make other changes to Ohio's Workforce Development Law.

To the Committee on Workforce and Economic Development.

**Sub. H. B. No. 2**-Representatives Derickson, Brown, et al.

To amend section 4141.29 of the Revised Code to require an unemployment compensation claimant to register with OhioMeansJobs to be eligible for unemployment compensation benefits and to require a claimant to contact a local one-stop office beginning with the eighth week of filing for unemployment compensation benefits.

To the Committee on Workforce and Economic Development.

**Am. H. B. No. 12**-Representative Roegner, et al.

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards.

**S. C. R. No. 11**-Senator Gentile, et al.

To urge the Congress of the United States to pass the Coalfield Accountability and Retired Employee Act.

To amend section 1505.07 of the Revised Code to ban the taking or removal of oil or natural gas from and under the bed of Lake Erie.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, 4111.04, 4111.05, 4111.06, 4111.07, 4111.09, 4111.11, 4111.12, 4111.13, 4111.17, 4111.99, and 4112.01 and to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 4111.17 (4112.16) of the Revised Code to enact the "Fair and Acceptable Income Required (FAIR) Act" and to revise the enforcement of the prohibitions against discrimination in the payment of wages.

To amend section 121.22 of the Revised Code to require that further information be stated in motions to hold executive sessions under the Open Meetings Act, to expand the fees and expenses that may be recovered for violation of the Act, and to make other changes to the Act.

To enact section 5.2285 of the Revised Code to designate the first week of October as "Ohio Forest Products Awareness Week."

To amend section 5705.19 and to enact section 307.059 of the Revised Code to authorize county commissioners to place the question of a property tax on the ballot for the purpose of providing funding to the probate court of the county to provide services for mentally ill or mentally incompetent adults in or from the county.

To the Committee on Ways and Means.

**S. B. No. 96**-Senator LaRose, et al.

To amend section 3313.603 of the Revised Code to require one unit of world history in the high school social studies curriculum.

To the Committee on Education.

**S. B. No. 97**-Senator Hughes, et al.

To enact section 4511.454 of the Revised Code to allow emergency personnel in public safety vehicles to report traffic law violations under certain circumstances.

To the Committee on Public Safety, Local Government, and Veterans Affairs.

To amend sections 1739.05 and 1751.35 and to enact sections 1751.69 and 3923.85 of the Revised Code regarding insurance coverage for orally administered cancer medications.

To amend sections 3901.38, 3901.383, and 3901.3814 and to repeal section 5111.178 of the Revised Code to specify that the Ohio prompt payment law applies to payment of claims by Medicaid managed care organizations.

To enact sections 5101.274 and 5902.021 of the Revised Code to establish a process for identifying individuals who are medical assistance recipients that may be eligible to receive federal military-related health care benefits.
