INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 329-Senator Schiavoni.

Cosponsors: Senators Gentile, Sawyer, Cafaro, Turner, Skindell, Brown, Tavares.

To amend sections 117.11 and 149.351 and to enact sections 117.102, 149.46, and 3314.031 of the Revised Code regarding audit and record-keeping requirements for community school sponsors and operators.

S. B. No. 330-Senator Cafaro.

Cosponsors: Senators Brown, Smith.

To amend section 1739.05 and to enact sections 1751.72, 3901.90, 3923.251, and 5160.33 of the Revised Code to amend the law related to the prior authorization requirements of insurers and of the medical assistance programs administered by the Department of Medicaid.

S. B. No. 331-Senator Gentile.

To enact section 5533.812 of the Revised Code to designate portions of State Route 43 and State Route 164 in Jefferson County as the "Veterans Memorial Highway."
