**REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND  
CONSIDERATION**

Senator Jordan reports for the Standing Committee on Reference, recommending that the following bills, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

**S. B. No. 102**-Senator Hughes, et al.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to create the "Ovarian Cancer Awareness" license plate.

To the Committee on Medicaid, Health and Human Services.

**S. B. No. 103**-Senator Skindell, et al.

To enact section 5533.921 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 2 in Cuyahoga County as the "Governor Richard F. Celeste Shoreway."

To the Committee on Transportation.

**S. B. No. 104**-Senator Skindell, et al.

To amend section 109.02 and to enact sections 3920.01 to 3920.15, 3920.21 to 3920.28, 3920.31, 3920.32, and 3920.33 of the Revised Code to establish and operate the Ohio Health Care Plan to provide universal health care coverage to all Ohio residents.

To the Committee on Medicaid, Health and Human Services.

**S. B. No. 105**-Senator Kearney, et al.

To amend sections 3701.74, 4723.481, 4723.50, 4730.39, 4730.40, 4730.43, 4765.11, 4765.16, 4765.35, and 4765.37 and to enact sections 3701.138, 3709.42, 4723.488, 4729.282, 4730.431, 4731.94, and 4765.161 of the Revised Code concerning the availability of naloxone.

To the Committee on Medicaid, Health and Human Services.

**S. B. No. 106**-Senator Schaffer.

To enact section 4511.714 of the Revised Code to prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle on or onto any location that is temporarily covered by a rise in water level and to impose on an offender a financial sanction of up to \$2,000 for the cost of the person's rescue, payable to the person's rescuer.

To the Committee on Transportation.

**S. B. No. 107**-Senators Patton, Turner, et al.

To amend sections 2903.13 and 2917.41 and to enact section 306.20 of the Revised Code to increase the penalty for assault when the victim is an employee of an Ohio transit system whom the offender knows or has reasonable cause to know is such an employee engaged in the performance of the victim's duties; to permit the court to impose a fine of up to \$5000 and a six-month or lifetime prohibition from riding an Ohio transit system for assault committed in such specified circumstances; to authorize Ohio transit systems to post a warning sign indicating that abuse or assault of staff will not be tolerated and might result in a felony conviction; and to increase the penalty for evading payment of the known fares of a public transportation system.
