**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 348**-Senator Tavares.

To enact section 5533.641 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of United States Route 33 within Columbus as the "John W. Bowen Memorial Roadway."

**S. B. No. 349**-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Patton, Eklund.

To amend sections 4112.02 and 4112.05 of the Revised Code to make permissive actual damages and attorney's fees, to limit certain punitive damages, to allow respondents to recover attorney's fees in certain instances, to prohibit actual or punitive damages from being awarded to a fair housing agency, and to exempt certain landlords from the housing provisions of the Ohio Civil Rights Law.
