BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

Am. H. B. No. 12-Representative Roegner.

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill, **Am. H. B. No. 12**, pass?"

On the motion of Senator Burke, **Am. H. B. No. 12** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

To amend sections 4506.09, 4713.60, 4723.24, 4725.16, 4725.51, 4732.14, 4733.15, 4743.04, 5903.10, 5903.12, and 5903.121 and to enact section

5903.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Occupational Licensing Law regarding military service members and veterans and to declare an emergency, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the section, Section 3, setting forth the emergency features of the bill, stand as a part of the bill?"

On the motion of Senator Burke, **Am. Sub. H. B. No. 98** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 163-Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsor: Senator Patton.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to increase the amount of unreimbursed medical expenses that an individual may deduct in computing Ohio income tax.

S. B. No. 164-Senator Tavares.

Cosponsors: Senators Kearney, Smith.

To amend section 5747.113 and to enact section 3343.11 of the Revised Code to authorize an income tax refund "check-off" contribution to support scholarships to attend Central State University.

S. B. No. 165-Senator Jordan.

To amend section 3798.04 and to enact sections 4731.73 and 4731.74 of the Revised Code to generally prohibit a physician from submitting any portion of a patient's medical record to an electronic database maintained by another party without authorization from the patient or the patient's representative and to prohibit a physician from asking a patient or prospective patient questions related to firearm ownership or possession.

S. B. No. 166-Senator Cafaro.

To amend sections 5162.01, 5162.20, 5165.15, and 5167.01, to enact sections 103.41, 103.411, 103.412, 103.413, 5162.70, 5162.71, 5163.04, 5164.16, 5164.882, 5164.94, 5167.15, and 6301.15, and to repeal sections 101.39 and 101.391 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing the Medicaid program, to create the Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee, to abolish the Joint Legislative Committee on Health Care Oversight and the Joint Legislative Committee on Medicaid Technology and Reform, and to make appropriations.
