BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

Am. H. B. No. 12-Representative Roegner.

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill, **Am. H. B. No. 12**, pass?"

5903.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Occupational Licensing Law regarding military service members and veterans and to declare an emergency, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the section, Section 3, setting forth the emergency features of the bill, stand as a part of the bill?"

On the motion of Senator Cafaro, **Am. Sub. H. B. No. 98** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

To amend sections 321.261, 323.131, 323.25, 323.28, 323.65, 323.69, 323.70, 323.71, 323.73, 323.78, 323.79, 715.261, 743.04, 2303.201, 2744.01, 5709.12, 5721.01, 5721.03, 5721.14, 5721.18, 5721.19, 5721.36, 5722.01, 5722.02, 5722.03, 5722.04, 5722.10, 5722.11, 5723.04, 5723.12, and 6119.06 and to enact sections 323.691 and 5722.031 of the Revised Code to modify the laws governing land reutilization programs and property tax foreclosures.

To amend section 4301.171 of the Revised Code to modify the law governing the sale of spirituous liquor tasting samples at an agency store.

S. B. No. 174-Senator Sawyer.

To amend sections 3335.02, 3335.09, 3337.01, 3339.01, 3341.02, 3343.02, 3343.06, 3344.01, 3350.10, 3352.01, 3356.01, 3359.01, 3361.01, 3362.01, and 3364.01 of the Revised Code to require the boards of trustees of state universities and the Northeast Ohio Medical University to adopt a resolution to grant or not grant to student members voting power and the authority to attend executive sessions.

S. B. No. 175-Senator LaRose.

To amend sections 3503.14, 3503.15, 3503.18, and 3503.21 and to enact sections 3503.05, 3503.20, 3503.22, and 3509.031 of the Revised Code to revise the law concerning voter registration and requests for absent voter's ballots.
