BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

Am. H. B. No. 12-Representative Roegner.

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill, **Am. H. B. No. 12**, pass?"

Senator Peterson moved that **Am. H. B. No. 12**, be informally passed and that it retains its place on the calendar.

5903.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Occupational Licensing Law regarding military service members and veterans and to declare an emergency, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the section, Section 3, setting forth the emergency features of the bill, stand as a part of the bill?"

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 176-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Burke, Schaffer.

To amend sections 2743.02, 2744.02, 2913.48, 4123.01, and 4123.511 and to enact sections 2307.82 and 4123.513 of the Revised Code to prohibit illegal and unauthorized aliens from receiving compensation and certain benefits under Ohio's Workers' Compensation Law.

S. B. No. 177-Senator Skindell.

Cosponsors: Senators Brown, Cafaro, Gentile, Kearney, Schiavoni, Sawyer, Smith, Tavares, Turner.

To amend sections 2903.213, 2903.214, 2919.26, and 3113.31 of the Revised Code to include the protection of companion animals in temporary protection orders, domestic violence protection orders, anti-stalking protection orders, and related protection orders.
