To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

It is my pleasure to present to you for the advice and consent of the Ohio Senate the reappointment of Gene Krebs to the Ohio Consumers' Counsel Governing Board pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4911.17.
