**BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION**

**Am. H. B. No. 12**-Representative Roegner.

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill, **Am. H. B. No. 12**, pass?"

5903.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Occupational Licensing Law regarding military service members and veterans and to declare an emergency, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the section, Section 3, setting forth the emergency features of the bill, stand as a part of the bill?"

### **INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 184**-Senator Patton.

To amend sections 2305.235 and 3701.99 and to enact section 3701.851 of the Revised Code to require a health club to have an automated external defibrillator installed on the premises, to specify requirements for training and staffing with respect to the use of that automated external defibrillator, and to modify the immunity provided with respect to the use of an automated external defibrillator.

**S. B. No. 185**-Senator Faber.

To enact section 5533.821 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 67 within Auglaize County as the "Staff Sgt. Sonny Zimmerman Memorial Highway."

**S. B. No. 186**-Senator Hughes.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to create the "Knights of Columbus" license plate.

To enact section 5.2288 of the Revised Code to designate the month of May as "Multiple Chemical Sensitivity Awareness Month."
