BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

To amend sections 4104.02 and 4104.05 of the Revised Code to eliminate the licensed operator requirement for boilers directly fired with gas, oil, gas-oil, or electricity or stationary steam engines that comply with standards established by the Board of Building Standards, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill, **Am. H. B. No. 12**, pass?"

On the motion of Senator Coley, **Am. H. B. No. 12** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

To amend sections 4506.09, 4713.60, 4723.24, 4725.16, 4725.51, 4732.14, 4733.15, 4743.04, 5903.10, 5903.12, and 5903.121 and to enact section 5903.03 of the Revised Code to revise the Occupational Licensing Law regarding military service members and veterans and to declare an emergency, having been informally passed, was considered the third time.

The question being, "Shall the section, Section 3, setting forth the emergency features of the bill, stand as a part of the bill?"

On the motion of Senator Coley, **Am. Sub. H. B. No. 98** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 193-Senator Seitz.

To amend sections 3501.01, 3501.07, 3505.03, 3505.08, 3505.10, 3506.11, 3513.01, 3513.04, 3513.05, 3513.31, 3513.311, 3513.312, 3517.01, 3517.012, 3517.02, 3517.03, 4503.03, and 5747.29 and to repeal section 3517.015 of the Revised Code to eliminate intermediate political parties and to revise the processes for determining political party status and for establishing new political parties.

S. B. No. 194-Senator Seitz.

To amend section 4511.68 of the Revised Code to allow certain motor-driven cycles and motor scooters to be parked on a sidewalk so long as the vehicles do not impede the normal flow of pedestrian traffic.
