The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 371**-Senators Turner, Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Seitz, Lehner, Schaffer, Hughes, Brown, Gardner.

To enact section 5533.464 of the Revised Code to designate State Route 306 within the municipal corporation of Kirtland as the "U.S.M.C. LCpl. Daniel G. Zegarac Memorial Highway."

**S. B. No. 372**-Senator Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Manning, Patton, Lehner, Seitz, Uecker.

To amend sections 119.03, 3719.01, 3719.41, and 3719.43 and to enact sections 109.44, 3719.45, and 3719.46 of the Revised Code authorizing the Ohio Attorney General to place certain substances on controlled substances schedule I.

**OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS**

To urge the United States Department of Commerce to utilize all available resources to prevent dumping and the subsidization of imported glass products in the United States finished glass market.
