The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 379**-Senator Jones.

Cosponsors: Senators Manning, Kearney.

To enact section 1349.83 of the Revised Code to ban the sale of products intended for use in electronic cigarettes that are not in child-resistant packaging.

**S. B. No. 380**-Senator Jones.

To amend sections 4928.54 and 4928.55 and to enact sections 4928.541, 4928.542, and 4928.543 of the Revised Code to modify the funding process for the percentage of income payment plan program.

**S. B. No. 381**-Senator Jones.

Cosponsors: Senators Lehner, Hite, Seitz, Turner.

To amend sections 5104.015, 5104.017, and 5104.018 and to enact section 5104.014 of the Revised Code to require children enrolled in licensed child care facilities to be immunized against specified diseases, subject to certain exceptions.

**S. B. No. 382**-Senators Jones, Smith.

Cosponsors: Senators Seitz, Hite, Skindell.

To amend sections 3119.01, 3119.02, 3119.021, 3119.022, 3119.023, 3119.03, 3119.04, 3119.05, 3119.06, 3119.22, 3119.23, 3119.24, 3119.29, 3119.30, 3119.302, 3119.31, 3119.32, 3119.61, 3119.63, 3119.76, 3119.79, 3119.89, 3121.36, and 3123.14; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicated in parentheses, sections 3119.022 (3119.024) and 3119.023 (3119.025); to enact new sections 3119.022 and 3119.023 and sections 3119.026, 3119.027, 3119.028, 3119.041, 3119.051, 3119.231, and 3119.303; and to repeal section 3119.024 of the Revised Code to make changes to the laws governing child support; and to amend section 3119.021 of the Revised Code on the date that is four years after the bill's effective date, to make conforming changes on that date.

**S. B. No. 383**-Senator LaRose.

Cosponsor: Senator Cafaro.

To enact section 1541.50 of the Revised Code to establish the State Recreational Vehicle Fund Advisory Board for the purpose of providing advice to the Department of Natural Resources regarding the use of state recreational vehicle money and studying the feasibility of establishing a grant program to fund recreational vehicle projects.
