INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 225-Senator Balderson.

Cosponsors: Senators Gardner, Hughes, Manning, Patton, Seitz, Schaffer, Kearney.

To enact section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to create the "Ohio Statehouse" license plate.

S. B. No. 226-Senator Beagle.

To enact section 5533.411 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 41 in Miami County as the "Sheriff's Sgt. Robert "Bobby" Elliott Memorial Highway."

S. B. No. 227-Senator Beagle.

Cosponsors: Senators Gardner, Hughes, Jones, Manning, Patton, Turner.

To enact section 5.2294 of the Revised Code to designate the second Tuesday of April as "Ohio Internship and Co-Op Appreciation Day."

S. B. No. 228-Senator Widener.

Cosponsors: Senators Patton, Uecker, Obhof, Schaffer, Seitz, Hughes, Oelslager.

To amend section 131.35 and to enact sections 127.163 and 124.164 of the Revised Code to limit the Controlling Board's authority to approve the expenditure of certain funds and to require state agencies to provide certain information to the Controlling Board regarding requested purchases from out-of-state suppliers.
