INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 385-Senator Brown.

To amend section 145.58 of the Revised Code to provide that Public Employees Retirement System members retiring on or after January 1, 2015, who have attained age sixty with fifteen or more years but less than twenty years of service credit on that date, are treated as retiring on or before December 1, 2014, for purposes of qualifying for any retiree health care coverage provided by the Retirement System and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 386-Senator Burke.

Cosponsors: Senators Seitz, Patton, Schiavoni.

To amend sections 1705.48, 3737.51, 3737.71, 3737.99, 3743.04, 3743.17, 3743.44, 3743.45, 3743.60, 3743.61, 3743.63, 3743.65, 3743.75, 3743.99, 5703.052, 5703.053, 5703.19, 5703.70, and 5703.77 and to enact sections 3737.04 to 3737.12, 3743.46, and 3743.47 of the Revised Code to enable individuals to purchase and use consumer grade fireworks, to extend to December 15, 2018, the moratorium on issuing fireworks manufacturer and wholesaler licenses, and to impose a fee on the retail sale of consumer grade fireworks in this state.
