INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 388-Senator Bacon.

Cosponsors: Senators LaRose, Lehner, Gardner, Hughes.

To amend sections 1901.20, 4511.094, and 4511.751; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 4511.093 (4511.092); to enact new section 4511.093 and sections 4511.095, 4511.096, 4511.097, 4511.098, 4511.099, 4511.0910, 4511.0911, and 4511.0912; and to repeal section 4511.092 of the Revised Code to establish conditions for the use by local authorities of traffic law photo-monitoring devices to detect certain traffic law violations.

S. B. No. 389-Senator Beagle.

Cosponsor: Senator Hite.

To amend sections 3109.051, 3109.11, 3109.12, and 5122.04 and to enact section 5122.041 of the Revised Code regarding minors and outpatient mental health treatment.
