**REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND  
CONSIDERATION**

Senator Jordan reports for the Standing Committee on Reference, recommending that the following bills, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

**Am. Sub. H. B. No. 107**-Representative Baker, et al.

To enact section 122.177 of the Revised Code to authorize the Development Services Agency to award grants to businesses that employ high school students in career exploration internships and to make an appropriation.

To the Committee on Finance.

**Sub. H. B. No. 296**-Representatives Johnson, Duffey, et al.

To amend sections 3313.713, 3313.718, 4729.51, and 4729.60 and to enact sections 3313.7110, 3314.143, 3326.28, 3328.29, and 5104.60 of the Revised Code to permit public schools, residential camps, and child day camps to procure epinephrine autoinjectors in accordance with prescribed procedures and to exempt them from licensing requirements related to the possession of epinephrine autoinjectors.

To the Committee on Medicaid, Health and Human Services.

**Am. Sub. H. B. No. 311**-Representatives Boose, Retherford, et al.

To amend sections 323.152 and 4503.065 of the Revised Code and Section 803.80 of Am. Sub. H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly to clarify the effective date of an income tax deduction, to extend the availability of a corporation franchise tax credit, to clarify that a person eligible for the homestead exemption without income limits continues to receive that exemption if the person's homestead changes, and to declare an emergency.

To amend Section 263.325 of Am. Sub. H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly to modify the membership structure of the Straight A Program Governing Board.

**S. B. No. 242**-Senator Sawyer, et al.

To amend section 3301.01 of the Revised Code to revise the membership composition of the State Board of Education.

To the Committee on Education.

**S. B. No. 243**-Senator Bacon.

To amend sections 5739.02 and 5739.05 of the Revised Code to provide a three-day sales tax "holiday" each August during which sales of back-to-school clothing, school supplies, personal computers, and personal computer accessories are exempt from sales and use taxes.

To the Committee on Ways and Means.

**S. B. No. 244**-Senators Jones, Gardner, et al.

To amend section 5747.70 of the Revised Code to increase the maximum income tax deduction for college savings contributions to \$10,000 annually for each beneficiary, to create the Joint Committee on Ohio College Affordability, and to declare an emergency.

To the Committee on Ways and Means.

**S. B. No. 245**-Senators Coley, Seitz, et al.

To enact sections 5533.542, 5533.543, 5533.544, and 5533.545 of the Revised Code to designate four new memorial highways in Butler, Hamilton, and Warren counties.

To the Committee on Transportation.

**S. B. No. 246**-Senator Tavares, et al.

To enact section 5533.611 of the Revised Code to designate the "G. Thomas Turner, Sr. I-70 East Entrance Ramp."

#### **INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 247**-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Brown, Gentile, Tavares, Seitz.

To amend section 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.82 of the Revised Code to authorize an income tax credit for residential landlords who improve a rental unit's energy efficiency.

**S. B. No. 248**-Senator Cafaro.

Cosponsors: Senators Brown, Turner, Schiavoni.

To amend sections 3313.60, 3314.06, and 3321.04 and to enact sections 2151.4210, 2151.4211, 2151.4212, 2151.4213, 2151.4214, 3314.063, 3321.042, and 3321.043 of the Revised Code to require a public children services agency to recommend whether a child should be admitted to an internet- or computer-based community school or excused by a school district superintendent from attendance at school for home education.
