WHEREAS, Ohio strives to improve the health and well-being of	3
its citizens in recognizing the importance of fighting chronic	4
diseases, such as coronary heart disease; and	5
WHEREAS, According to the National Heart, Lung, and Blood	6
Institute in the National Institutes of Health, coronary heart	7
disease is the leading cause of death in the United States. The	8
United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports	9
that this disease contributes to about one of every five deaths	10
nationally and heart disease, in general, was the cause of death	11
of 27,886 Ohioans in 2006 alone; and	12
WHEREAS, The American Heart Association estimates that the	13
direct and indirect cost of treating coronary heart disease in	14
this country in 2009 will be \$165.4 billion, with a staggering	15
