RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of the 128th General Assembly of Ohio, in adopting this Resolution, permit The United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit to use the Ohio House Chambers for its Seventieth Conference, contingent upon the availability of those facilities; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House transmit a duly authenticated copy of this Resolution to The United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.
