JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to enact Section 1 of Article XIV of the	1
Constitution of the State of Ohio to create the	2
Ohio Livestock Care Standards Board.	3

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Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio, three-fifths of the members elected to each house concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, in the manner prescribed by law at the general election to be held on November 3, 2009, a proposal to enact Section 1 of Article XIV of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to read as follows: 10

ARTICLE XIV	11
Section 1. (A) There is hereby created the Ohio Livestock	12
Care Standards Board for the purpose of establishing standards	13
governing the care and well-being of livestock and poultry in this	14
state. In carrying out its purpose, the Board shall endeavor to	15
maintain food safety, encourage locally grown and raised food, and	16
protect Ohio farms and families. The Board shall be comprised of	17
the following thirteen members:	18
(1) The director of the state department that regulates	19
agriculture who shall be the chairperson of the Board;	20
(2) Ten members appointed by the Governor with the advice and	21
consent of the Senate. The ten members appointed by the Governor	22
shall be residents of this state and shall include the following:	23
(a) One member representing family farms;	24
(b) One member who is knowledgeable about food safety in this	25
<u>state;</u>	
(c) Two members representing statewide organizations that	27
represent farmers;	28
(d) One member who is a veterinarian who is licensed in this	29
<u>state;</u>	30
(e) The State Veterinarian in the state department that	31
regulates agriculture;	32
(f) The dean of the agriculture department of a college or	33
university located in this state;	34
(g) Two members of the public representing Ohio consumers;	35
(h) One member representing a county humane society that is	36
organized under state law.	37
(3) One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of	38
Representatives who shall be a family farmer;	39

shall be a family farmer.

Not more than seven members appointed to the Board at any 42 given time shall be of the same political party. 43

(B) The Board shall have authority to establish standards 44 governing the care and well-being of livestock and poultry in this 45 state, subject to the authority of the General Assembly. In 46 establishing those standards, the Board shall consider factors 47 that include, but are not limited to, agricultural best management 48 practices for such care and well-being, biosecurity, disease 49 prevention, animal morbidity and mortality data, food safety 50 practices, and the protection of local, affordable food supplies 51 52 for consumers.

(C) The state department that regulates agriculture shall have the authority to administer and enforce the standards established by the Board.

(D) The General Assembly may enact laws that it deems 56 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section, to facilitate 57 the execution of the duties of the Board and the state department 58 that regulates agriculture under this section, and to set the 59 terms of office of the Board members and conditions for the Board 60 members' service on the Board. 61

(E) If any part of this section is held invalid, the 62 remainder of this section shall not be affected by that holding 63 and shall continue in full force and effect. 64 65

EFFECTIVE DATE

If adopted by a majority of the electors voting on this 66 proposal at the general election held November 3, 2009, the 67 enactment of Section 1 of Article XIV of the Constitution of the 68 State of Ohio takes effect immediately. 69

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
