### RESOLUTION

Honoring David Dinsmore as a 2013 USA Diving Winter National Champion.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 130th General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to congratulate David Dinsmore on winning the men's synchronized ten-meter platform event at the 2013 USA Diving Winter National Championships; and

WHEREAS, A junior at New Albany High School and a member of the Ohio State Diving Club, David Dinsmore has combined talent and competitive spirit with the highest ideals of good sportsmanship to establish himself as a truly exceptional athlete. With admirable dedication, he has worked diligently toward attaining ultimate proficiency in diving, and as a result, he scored 1,240.6 points to win second place in the men's ten-meter platform event and combined with his partner, Steele Johnson, to score 823.77 points to win first place in the men's synchronized ten-meter platform event at the 2013 USA Diving Winter National Championships. In addition, he scored 557.15 points to win first place in the men's ten-meter platform event to qualify for the 2014 Youth Olympic Games Qualifier and the 2014 Federation Internationale de Natation World Cup and Grand Prix; and
