## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, In 2013, glassware imports into the United States	5
exceeded exports by as much as \$1.6 billion; and	б
WHEREAS, Foreign glass manufacturers are subsidizing glass	7
imports and are selling imports in the United States at a lower	8
price than normally charged in the foreign manufacturer's home	9
country, a practice known as "dumping"; and	10
WHEREAS, Between 2004 and 2008, Chinese glass manufacturers	11
received approximately \$30.3 billion in subsidies; and	12
WHEREAS, These unfair trade practices create an uneven	13
playing field for United States glass manufacturers; and	14
WHEREAS, The United States government must take action to	15
protect the jobs and livelihood of our domestic glass	16
manufacturers and workers; now therefore be it	17

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Senate of the 130th 18 General Assembly of the State of Ohio urge the United States 19 Department of Commerce to conduct a thorough investigation into 20 unfair trade practices of foreign glass manufacturers and to 21 utilize all available resources to prevent dumping and the 22 subsidization of imported glass products in the United States 23 finished glass market; and be it further 24
