BILL SUMMARY

- Adopts the spotted salamander as the state amphibian.
- Adopts the bullfrog as the state frog.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the salamander, *Ambystoma maculatum*, commonly known as the spotted salamander, as the official amphibian of the state. (R.C. 5.033.)

The bill also designates the frog, *Rana catesbeiana*, commonly known as the bullfrog, as the official frog of the state. (R.C. 5.034.)
