BILL SUMMARY

• Removes a prohibition under which an insurer could not charge different automobile insurance rates based solely on the fact that the insured person lives within the limits of a municipal corporation.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Automobile insurance rates

With respect to private passenger automobile insurance, current law prohibits an insurer from charging different premium rates to persons residing within the limits of a municipal corporation based solely on the location of the insured's residence within those limits. The bill removes that prohibition. (R.C. 3901.21.)
