BILL SUMMARY

• Designates the portion of United States Route 62, located in Stark County, commencing at the intersection of that route with State Route 93 and extending in a northeasterly direction to the intersection of that route with Mt. Eaton Street Southwest, as the "U.S. Army Spc. Zachary Grass Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Army Spc. Zachary Grass died in Iraq on June 16, 2007, when the vehicle in which he was riding struck an improvised explosive device.
