BILL SUMMARY

- Increases the legally permitted alcohol content of beer from 12% to 21% of alcohol by volume (R.C. 4301.01).
- Prohibits beer that contains more than 12% of alcohol by volume from including caffeine or other stimulants, including guarana, ginseng, or taurine (R.C. 4301.71).
- Specifies that the prohibition against the use of stimulants in beer that contains more than 12% alcohol by volume does not apply to beer that has incidental amounts of caffeine from coffee, chocolate, or tea (R.C. 4301.71).
