BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of United States Route 50, commencing at the point where the road that carries the designations of both that route and United States Route 35 south of Chillicothe diverges and proceeding in a southeasterly direction to the intersection of United States Route 50 and State Route 327 within Ross County only, as the "Lance Cpl. Aaron Reed Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Lance Cpl. Aaron Reed was killed in Iraq on August 4, 2005, when the assault vehicle in which he was riding was hit by an improvised explosive device during combat operations.

The portion of United States Route 50 that is the subject of the bill currently carries the designation "George Washington Highway."²
