BILL SUMMARY

- Requires the State Board of Education to recommend performance standards for dropout prevention and recovery programs operated by school districts.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill directs the State Board of Education to recommend to the General Assembly performance standards for dropout prevention and recovery programs operated by school districts. The recommendations are due by one year after the bill's effective date.¹
