BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of State Route 264, commencing at the municipal corporation of Cleves and extending in an easterly direction to the intersection of that route and South Road within Hamilton County only, as the "Sergeant David Kreuter Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Sergeant David Kreuter was killed in Iraq on August 3, 2005, when the assault vehicle in which he was riding was hit by an improvised explosive device during combat operations.
