BILL SUMMARY

• Designates a portion of State Route 44 in Stark County (from State Route 619 to the Portage County boundary) as the "First Lt. Ashley White Stumpf Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

First Lt. Ashley White Stumpf died October 22, 2011 in Kandahar, Afghanistan of wounds suffered when her unit was attacked with an improvised explosive device.
