BILL SUMMARY

 Designates part of State Route 800, commencing at the northeast border of Freeport in Harrison County and extending in a northeasterly direction to the intersection of State Route 800 and State Route 799, as the "Trooper George Conn Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

State Highway Patrol Trooper George Conn was shot and killed while on duty near Freeport on September 27, 1937.
