- Designates a portion of State Route 2 located in Cuyahoga County and also known as the Cleveland Memorial Shoreway, commencing at Lake Avenue and extending in an easterly direction to the point at which the road crosses the Cuyahoga River, as the "Governor Richard F. Celeste Shoreway."¹
