BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of State Route 44, commencing at the intersection of that road with Cherry Avenue in the municipal corporation of Chardon and proceeding in a northerly direction to the boundary of Geauga County and Lake County, as "The Danny Parmertor Memorial Highway."¹
- Designates the portion of State Route 6, commencing at the intersection of that road with State Route 44 in the municipal corporation of Chardon and proceeding in a westerly direction to the boundary of Geauga County and Lake County, as "The Demetrius C. Hewlin Memorial Highway."²
- Designates the portion of the road known within Geauga County as Claridon Road and also Aquilla Road, commencing at the intersection of that road with State Route 44 in the municipal corporation of Chardon and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of that road with State Route 87, as the "Russell King, Jr., Memorial Highway."³
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along each highway indicating its name.
