BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of Interstate Route 70 in Clark County, running in an easterly and westerly direction between mile marker 51 and mile marker 53, as the "Trooper Charles V. Vogel Memorial Highway," in addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise.
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Trooper Charles V. Vogel died from injuries he suffered on January 24, 1980; he was struck by a car while investigating a series of motor vehicle crashes at the junction of Interstate Route 70 and United States Route 68.
