BILL SUMMARY

- Designates both of the following portions of United States Route 422 as the "Arnold R. Pinkney Memorial Way":
 - The portion located within Cleveland only, commencing at the intersection of that route and Woodland Avenue and East Fifty-fifth Street and proceeding in an easterly direction to the boundary of Cleveland and Shaker Heights; and
 - The portion located within Youngstown only, commencing at the intersection of State Route 422 and North Lane Avenue and proceeding in an easterly direction to the intersection of that route and State Route 616.¹
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along each portion of the highway indicating its name.²
