BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of United States Route 40, commencing at the intersection of that route with North Medway-Carlisle Road and proceeding in a northeasterly direction to the intersection of that route and Lammes Lane in Clark County only, as the "Staff Sergeant Wesley Williams Memorial Highway."
- Declares that the designation is in addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise.
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Army Staff Sergeant Wesley Williams died on December 10, 2012, in Kandahar, Afghanistan, of wounds he suffered when his unit was attacked by enemy forces using an improvised explosive device.
