#### **BILL SUMMARY**

• Designates September as "Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month."

#### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

#### **Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month**

The bill designates the month of September as "Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month."<sup>1</sup>

Parkinson's disease is a motor system disorder that results from the loss of brain cells that produce dopamine, which helps to coordinate and control muscle activity. The four primary symptoms of Parkinson's disease are as follows: (1) trembling in the hands, arms, legs, jaw, and face, (2) stiffness of the limbs and trunk, (3) slowness of movement, and (4) impaired balance and coordination. As these symptoms become more pronounced, an individual may have difficulty walking, talking, or completing simple tasks.<sup>2</sup>
