#### **BILL SUMMARY**

• Requires the issuance of free fishing and hunting licenses, fur taker, deer, and wild turkey permits, and wetlands habitat stamps to Ohio residents who are at least 65.

### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill requires an Ohio resident who is at least 65 to be issued a free annual fishing or hunting license, fur taker, deer, or wild turkey permit, or wetlands habitat stamp, or any combination, upon application to the Chief of the Division of Wildlife.<sup>1</sup> Current law instead provides for both of the following:

- (1) An Ohio resident who is at least 66 to be issued a half-price senior hunting or fishing license or deer, wild turkey, or fur taker permit; and
- (2) An Ohio resident born on or before December 31, 1937, to be issued a free fishing or hunting license, fur taker, deer, and wild turkey permit, or wetlands habitat stamp.<sup>2</sup>
